The Local 6 Apprenticeship Program is a four-year program. During your apprenticeship you will attend school two days per month from September through June. You will not be paid on the days you attend school. The starting wage rate is \$20.50 to \$25.63 depending upon the area where you are working.

Application Process:

Once you have submitted your application the next step in the process is the test which is scheduled for **April 18, 19 and 20**. You will be notified by mail of the date and time you are scheduled to take the test. **If you do not receive a test notification by April 12, 2023, call us at 617-436-4666.** If you miss the test, you will be eliminated from consideration for this year's program, so it is extremely important that you call us if you do not receive your notification by **4/12/23**. The test officials do not do make-up tests for any reason. Your only opportunity to take the test this year will be the dates listed above. The test is managed by State officials and takes approximately 75 minutes. You will take the test here at the union hall. **The doors are locked at the scheduled time, so you must arrive prior to that time.** The test is a basic aptitude test with math word problems and a timed manual dexterity test. The tests are scored "High, Medium, or Low". If you receive a low on the test you will not be considered for a place in the 2023 program. You will be notified by mail if you receive a low on the test. You may reapply next year.

The next step is an interview before the JAC Committee. The interviews are scheduled for **May 22, 23 and 24**. If you receive a high or a medium on the test you will be notified by mail of the date and time of your interview. **If you do not receive your interview notice by May 17, 2023, call us at 617-436-4666.** If you miss your interview your name will not be included on the 2023 Apprenticeship List. The JAC Committee consists of three union officials and three union contractors. The interview takes about ten minutes. Once all the interviews are completed the 2023 Apprenticeship List will be established. You will be notified by letter of your standing on the list.

We will begin taking in new apprentices, from the applicants at the top of list, in late June or early July. To be considered for acceptance to the program you must finish in the top 30-35 on the list. If your number is higher than 35 it is not likely you will be called. There is also no guarantee that you will be called even if you are in the top 35. The number of apprentices being accepted depends upon our workload.

Once you are accepted you will receive a phone call from the Business Manager or Business Agent notifying you that you are being put to work. Once you receive their call you will have 24 hours to report to be drug tested. You will be permitted time to give a two week notice to your current employer.

Applicants not being considered for the apprentice program this year may reapply next year.
