

THERE ARE UPDATES TO YOUR COVID-19 COVERAGE

Throughout the pandemic, we've remained committed to supporting your needs. As part of the federal government's declaration of a public health emergency, we temporarily expanded coverage for COVID-19 tests, vaccines, and treatment.

Here's what's staying the same

The public health emergency ends May 11, 2023. Starting May 12:

- Diagnostic COVID-19 tests ordered by a provider will continue to be covered at no cost to members
- COVID-19 vaccines will continue to be covered at no cost to members when administered by innetwork clinicians and pharmacies
- Most COVID-19 treatments and services, including Paxlovid, will continue to be covered at no cost to members

Here's what's changing

Starting May 12, we'll return to our original policy for over-the-counter (OTC) COVID-19 tests, which means they won't be covered under your medical or pharmacy coverage. Keep in mind, these tests are still widely available at your local pharmacy.
